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
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
Keys to Success in Advanced Primary Care

- High value care with Integrated Whole-Person Advanced primary care team implementation
- Proactive population health strategy
 - >Accurate risk stratification
 - >Primary care team proactive outreach based on risk
 - ➤ Risk assessment and capture as part of primary care workflow
- High value visit model to engage high risk patients with their care team



APC Proactive Care Model







Advanced Primary Care Implementation: Impact on Cost of Care

- PMPY Spend:
 - 3/31/23 = \$5102
 - 5/31/24 = \$4631 (9.2% reduction in TCC on PMPY basis)
 - (-)\$471 PMPY per member with implementation

- Population = 37531 (average of last 12 months)
- PMPM cost reduction in past 15 months= \$17,677,101
- 22% Reduction in ED visits
- 20% Reduction in Hospital Days












