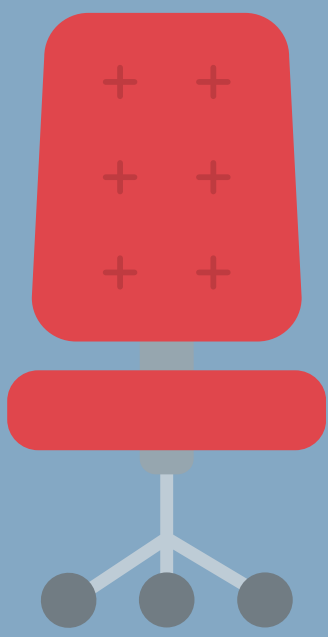

FINANCIAL SITUATION

Have open positions that they cannot fill **25%**

Salaries skipped or deferred over the last 4 weeks **20%**



Face-to-face patient visits continue to be much lower than pre-pandemic levels **44%**

Have had private insurers pull back on payments for telemedicine **21%**

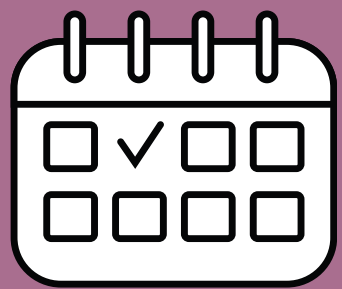
SUPPORT FOR TELEHEALTH IS DECLINING



Patient mental health burden is heavier than usual (where telehealth could work well)
