1. Purpose

The purpose of the P & T committee is to promote improved patient care and safety by supporting the medication management initiatives of OU Physicians.

2. Scope

Provide support and recommendations for the medication management requirements of external constituents (e.g. NCQA, OHCA, and CPCI)

Maintain medication custom lists in the EMR

Maintain a medication error and adverse event reporting and review process

Maintain procedures for responding to medication alerts issued by the FDA

Standardize medication management protocols for medications identified as high risk (e.g. statins & warfarin)

3. Bylaws

- 1. This committee is established as a Sub-Committee to the Medical Directors' Committee according to the OUP-Tulsa Governance Policies.
- 2. Regular reports (at least quarterly) will be provided to the Medical Directors' Committee
- 3. Meetings will be held at a regularly recurring meeting time established by the chairman.

4. Membership

- 1. **Chair Michelle Condren, Pharm.D.** Presides over meetings, sees that the resolutions passed by the members are carried out, reports during Medical Directors' Committee meetings.
- 2. **Staff Susan Spooner, Clinical Risk Manager.** Keeps a record of the actions authorized by the members, and notifies members of meetings and activities.
- 3. **Members** Attend monthly and special meetings. Prepare for monthly or special meetings by reading distributed documents prior to the meeting. Communicate decisions to his/her department/clinic. Membership will include, at a minimum:
 - a. Pharmacists from each of the following clinics: Pediatrics, Family Medicine, Internal Medicine.
 - b. A representative from medical informatics.
 - c. Ad-hoc Renee Engleking, Executive Director, OU Physicians Tulsa

5. Impacted/Impacting Committees & Departments

5.1 Committees

Medical Records. The Medical Records committee will set guidelines and standards as they relate to what, when, and how information is placed in the medical record. Will seek

guidance from P&T Committee regarding medication management process and the medical record.

New Technology & Business Development. The New Technology and Business Development committee will assess new opportunities for OU-Physicians. Many times, these new opportunities introduce new medications or procedures within OUP Clinics.

Risk Management Committee. Risk Management Committee will report medication error trends to the P&T Committee.

Medical Informatics. The Medical Informatics department manages EMR

Pharmacy. Faculty members participate as members of the P&T Committee, serve as faculty and resource in outpatient practices and provide pharmacy services within OUP Clinics
